RULES

- 1) This is a no-tap singles tournament, meaning 9 pins or better on your first ball is considered a strike.**
- 2) Entry fee is \$15. \$7.50 for lineage (3 games) and \$7.50 goes in the prize fund. 1 in 8 entries will cash. 100% prize money returned. Entries accepted on a first come (paid), first served basis up to 40 entries (full squad).**
- 3) This tournament will be held at Capitol Bowl – Owosso on Sunday December 4. Registration will be between 4pm and 4:30pm. Lanes will be randomly assigned at 4:40pm. Practice will begin at 4:50pm and the tournament will start promptly at 5pm. Late entries will not be accepted. You will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes.**
- 4) Handicap will be 90% of 220. Bowlers will use their highest USBC final average of at least 21 games from the 2010-2011 season. If no 2010-2011 average, then you may use your current USBC average of at least 21 games. The 10-pin rule is in effect. Sport Shot averages will be adjusted based on the USBC conversion chart. All others must bowl scratch. Non-Capitol Bowl entrants **MUST** bring proof of your current average. Reporting an incorrect average may result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees/prizes.**
- 5) PRIZES WILL BE PAID ONLY AFTER WINNING AVERAGES HAVE BEEN VERIFIED.**
- 6) This tournament is NOT USBC sanctioned, but USBC rules will be followed and is open to all sanctioned and non-sanctioned adult bowlers.**
- 7) Tournament manager(s) must make any scoring adjustments.**
- 8) Tournament manager will make the final decision on any matter not covered in the rules.**
